**Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984)**

**The County of Cornwall (A39 Between Treskinnick Cross And Wainhouse Corner, Poundstock, Bude, A39 Between Wainhouse Corner And Collamoor Head, St Gennys, Bude and Cansford Dip, Otterham, Camelford) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2025**

1. The Cornwall Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by traffic over an area of highway being A39 Between Treskinnick Cross And Wainhouse Corner, Poundstock, Bude and A39 Between Wainhouse Corner And Collamoor Head, St Gennys, Bude for their entire lengths and Cansford Dip, Otterham, Camelford between the Layby at Cansford Dip and grid reference SX 17400 93480 as highlighted by the red dashed line on the plan attached to this Order.
2. The Order shall come into operation on 3rd March 2025 and shall remain in force for eighteen months, however, this order can be extended by the Secretary of State for Transport. The works are expected to be completed by the 22nd March 2025.
3. The prohibition will be in force between the hours of 1900 and 0600, weekends included.
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall remain in force on such days and during such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. In this Order "traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type described or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
5. The Council is satisfied that the prohibition is needed because surfacing works are being executed on or near the road.
6. While the Order is in operation traffic, including bicycle movement, along the highway specified in paragraph 1, will be temporarily restricted. No person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle or pedal cycle to enter on, proceed or wait in the length of highway described above.

**Nothing in the Order will apply to:**

Any police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard vehicle, or any personnel on official duty, or any vehicle or person authorised by and with the permission of Cornwall Council.

Any vehicle being used for the purposes of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitate the bringing of vehicles into the section of highway to which this order applies.

Traffic associated with the works required within the highway specified above.

School buses.

An alternative route will be available for use while the Order is in force being A39 Between Boxs Shop And Treskinnick Cross, A39 Between Helebridge Road And Boxs Shop, A39 Between Binhamy Road And Helebridge Road, Binhamy Road, A39 Between New Road And Binhamy Road, New Road, Hospital Road, Bridge Street, Howells Road, A3072 Between Howells Road And Red Post, Laybys On A3072 Between Howells Road And Red Post, A3072 Between Tamarston Bridge And Red Post, A39 Between Titchsborough Hill And Green Pastures, Titchsborough Hill, Atlantic Highway, Cansford Dip, Western Road, Carboth Lane, St Thomas Road, Wooda Lane, Newport Square, Dutson Road, A388 Between County Boundary And Dutson Road, Western Road, A30 J A388 West Of Launceston Leave E, Sliproad Off A30 Dual Carriageway Eastbound To Western Road, Western Road, Western Road, Sliproad Off A30 Dual Carriageway Westbound At Launceston, A30 J A388 West Of Launceston Leave W, Sliproad Onto A30 Dual Carriageway Westbound At Launceston From Western Road, A30 J A388 West Of Launceston Join W, A30 Through J A388 West Of Launceston W, A30 Dual Carriageway Westbound From Launceston To Temple Tor Junction, A30 From J A388 West Of Launceston To J A395 E, A30 Through J A395 W, A30 Offslip From Dual Carriageway Westbound From Launceston To Temple Tor, A30 J A395 Leave W, A395 From Trethorne Golf Club To Kennards House, A30 J A395 Join E, Sliproad Onto A30 Dual Carriageway Eastbound At Tregadillet, A30 Through J A395 E, A30 Dual Carriageway Eastbound From Temple Tor To Launceston, A30 From J A395 To J A388 West Of Launceston E, Sliproad Off A30 Dual Carriageway Eastbound To Western Road, A30 J A388 West Of Launceston Leave E, One Way Lane, Vicarage Hill, Church Hill, A395 Between Church Hill And Tresoke, A395 Between Tresoke And Cold Northcott Farm, A395 Between Cold Northcott Farm And Trefrank Road, A395 Between Trefrank Road And Downhead, A395 Between Downhead And Pipers Pool, A395 Between Pipers Pool And Kennards House, A395 From Trethorne Golf Club To Kennards House.
