Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (RTRA 1984)

Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Notice

The Cornwall Council hereby gives notice under Section 14 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 prohibiting the use by traffic over an area of highway being Hatchs Hill, Steamers Hill, Angarrack Lane, Angarrack, for their entire length. The notice shall come into force on the 6th February 2024 for a period of up to 21 days, however, it is expected that the works will be completed by the 8th February 2024.

The prohibition will be in force between the hours of 07:30 and 17:00 on a daily basis, weekdays only.

If the works cannot be completed during that period, the Council may issue a further notice under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary Order under section 14(1) of that Act, so as to continue in force the provisions of this notice for a further period of time.

It is necessary for the above restriction to come into force without delay because of works being executed on or near the road to carry out repairs to skid resistance.

The restrictions imposed by this notice shall remain in force on such days and during such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. In this order "traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type described or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

While the Notice is in operation traffic, along the highway specified in paragraph 1, will be temporarily restricted. No personnel, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle, proceed or wait in the length of highway described above.

Nothing in the Notice will apply to:

Any police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard vehicle, buses, cyclists or any personnel on official duty, or any vehicle or person authorised by and with the permission of Cornwall Council.

Any vehicle being used for the purposes of an undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which necessitate the bringing of vehicles into the section of road to which this order applies.

Traffic associated with the works required within the highway specified above.

An alternative route will be available for use while the notice is in force.

Pedestrian and Vehicular access to residents and businesses will be maintained.

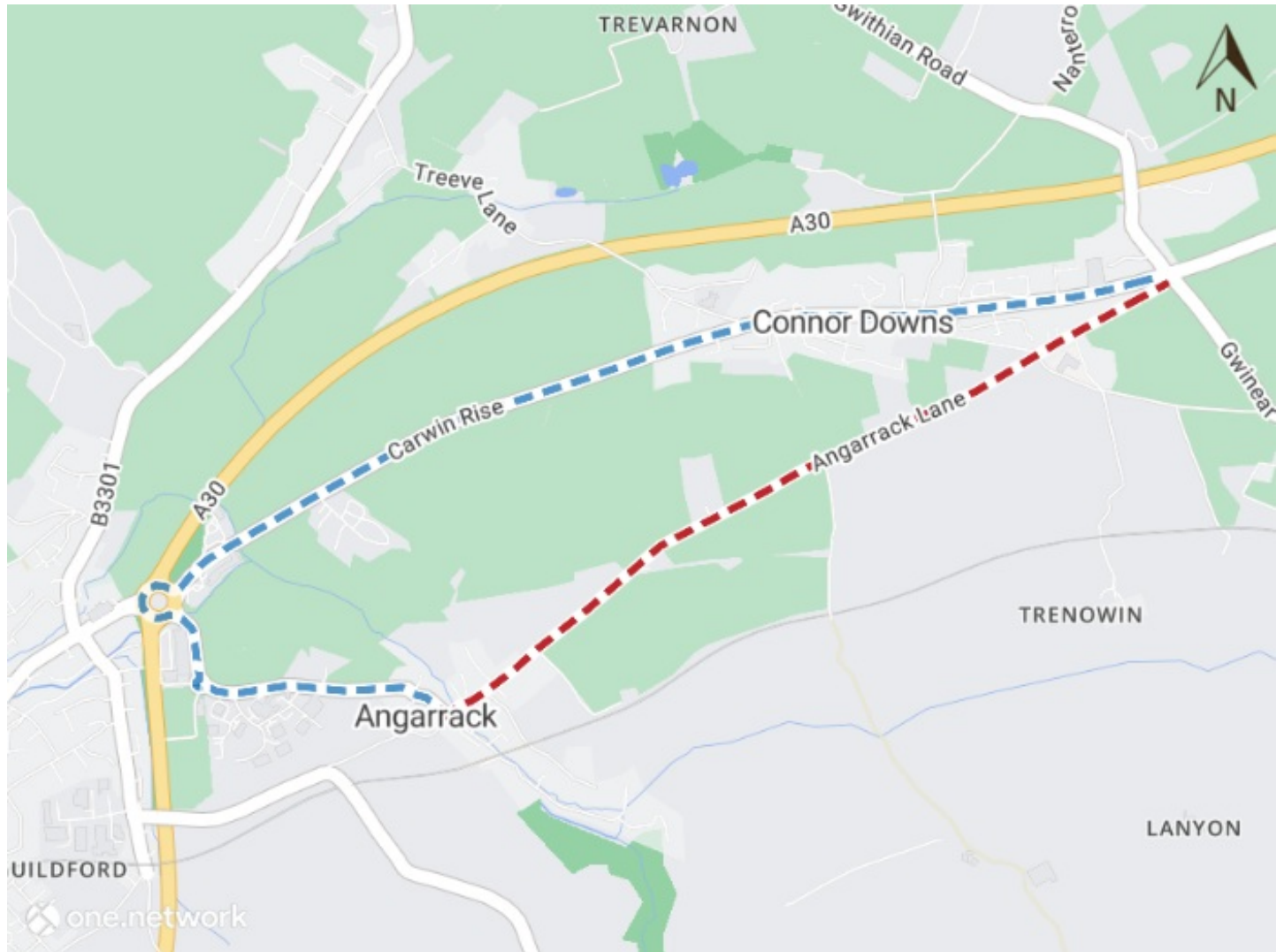
