PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC

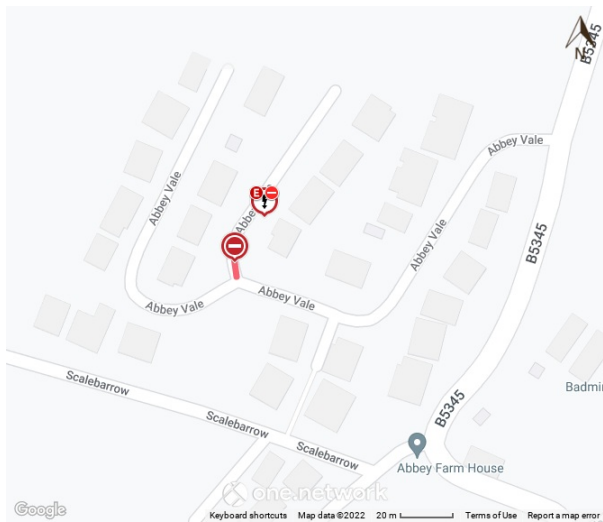
U4125 ABBEY VALE, ST BEES

Notice is hereby given, that because of the likelihood of danger to the public as a result of electricity mains requiring repairs, Cumbria County Council hereby prohibits the passage of vehicles along that section of the U4125 Abbey Vale, St Bees extending in a north westerly direction for a total distance of approximately 10 metres.

This notice will be in force for a period of up to 21 days from 14th October 2022, as and when the relevant signs are displayed. It is anticipated that the restriction will be required for 6 days.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.



Nothing in this Notice shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with any repair works.
