URGENT TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

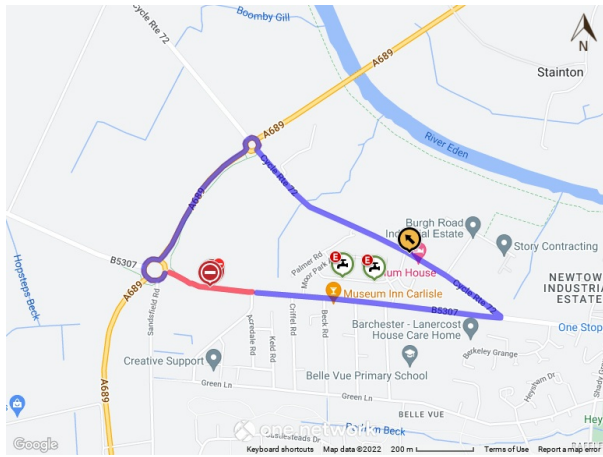
B5307 Moorhouse Road, Carlisle

Notice is hereby given that to enable Cumbria Highways, to carry out urgent repairs to the highway ("the Works") Cumbria County Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of vehicular traffic along that section of the B5307 Moorhouse Road from its junction with Kirkstead Road, extending in a westerly direction for a total distance of approximately 300 metres, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 6th June 2022. It is expected that the Works will take 2 days.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections Moorhouse Road, Burgh Road & A689.

Nothing in this Notice shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
