URGENT TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE


A689 CARLISLE

Notice is hereby given that to enable Balfour Beatty to carry out urgent highway repairs ("the Works"), Cumbria County Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of vehicular traffic along that section of A689 Carlisle from its junction with the A595 to its junction with the A7, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 30th January 2023. It is expected that the Works will take 3 days, between the hours of 19:00 and 06:00.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections of the A7 & A595

Nothing in this Notice shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Work
