URGENT ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

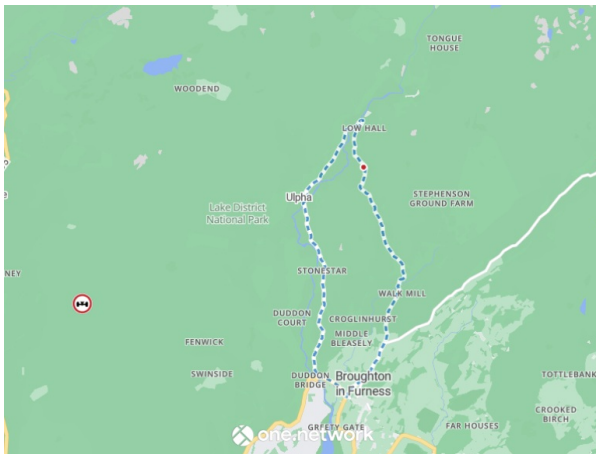
C5008 KILN BANK CROSS CATTLE GRID

Notice is hereby given that to enable Cumbria Highways to carry out urgent repair works to the cattle grid ("the Works") Cumbria County Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of vehicular traffic along that section of C5008 Kiln Bank Cattle grid, extending in a south westerly direction for a total distance of approximately 20 metres, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 27th February 2023. It is expected that the Works will take 4 days.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections of C5008, A593, A595 Broughton in Furness, C5007, & C4028.

Nothing in this Notice shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
