

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (EDINBURGH AVENUE AND WELLS CLOSE,
WORKINGTON AND MOSEDALE CRESCENT, MARYPORT)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Northern Gas Networks to carry out utility works ("the Works"), the County Council of Cumbria intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:-

1. Edinburgh Avenue, Workington: From its junction with Furness Road extending in a north westerly direction for approx. 55m.
Alternative route: via the Furness Road, Calder Drive, and the unrestricted section of Edinburgh Avenue.
From: 9 August 2021 for approx. 1 day (Ref: AL21-329)
2. Wells Close, Workington: From its junction with Furness Road extending in a north westerly direction for its entirety.
No suitable alternative route available.
From: 16 August 2021 for approx. 1 day (Ref: AL21-331)
3. Mosedale Crescent, Maryport: From its junction with Ewanrigg Road extending in a south westerly direction for approx. 25m.
Alternative route: via the unrestricted section of Mosedale Crescent and Ewanrigg Road.
From: 30 August 2021 for approx. 1 day (Ref: AL21-323)

Suitable diversion routes will be indicated on site by the display of relevant traffic signs as and when the temporary closures are in force.

The above closures will not necessarily be done in numerical order.

The contractor will ensure that local residents and the general public are informed of which roads are to be closed and when, nearer the time.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.

The Order will come into operation on 9 August 2021 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as specified above and only as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.
