TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021

U1204 CASTLE CARROCK

Cumbria County Council made an order to enable Network Rail to carry out utility works ("the Works) which came into operation on 21st March 2022.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the section of the U1204 Castle Carrock, from its junction with C1031, extending in a south direction, for approx. 425m.

The Works have been rescheduled and will now be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 5th September 2022 and is expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 5 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted section of the U1204, C1024 and C1031.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
