## (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023

## **ULPHA BRIDGE, BROUGHTON IN FURNESS**

Cumbria County Council made an order to enable Metcalfe Plant Hire ("the Works) which came into operation on 7 November 2022.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along from its junction with Bobbin Mill Hill extending in a south easterly direction for approx. 75m.

The Works have been rescheduled and will now be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 13th March 2023 and is expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 12 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the C4028, A595, and C5007.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
