

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Essex County Council (Church Lane, Stow Maries) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2025

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council has made the above Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To temporarily close that length of Church Lane, Stow Maries, in the District of Maldon, from a point approximately 415m south east of its junction with Woodham Road for a distance of approximately 50m in a south easterly direction.

The closure is scheduled to continue from 12th February for 526 days, or where stated on a valid permit (EP20115125434 - Essex County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [one.network](#).

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works to safeguard a weak bridge works are undertaken by Essex County Council.

An alternative route is available via Church Lane, Lower Burnham Road, Woodham Road and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The Order came into effect on 13th February 2025 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
