

PUBLIC NOTICE

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(2)

Temporary closure of Church Lane, Stow Maries

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, the Essex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Church Lane, Stow Maries, in the District of Maldon under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, from a point approximately 415m south east of its junction with Woodham Road for a distance of approximately 50m in a south easterly direction.

The temporary emergency closure commenced on 23rd January 2025 and will be in force for up to 21 days (It is estimated to be completed on 12th February 2025, however, please check [one.network](#) for the most up to date information on duration of the emergency closure). The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce whilst Essex County Council undertakes works to safeguard a weak bridge.

The alternative route is via: Church Lane, Lower Burnham Road, Woodham Road and vice versa.

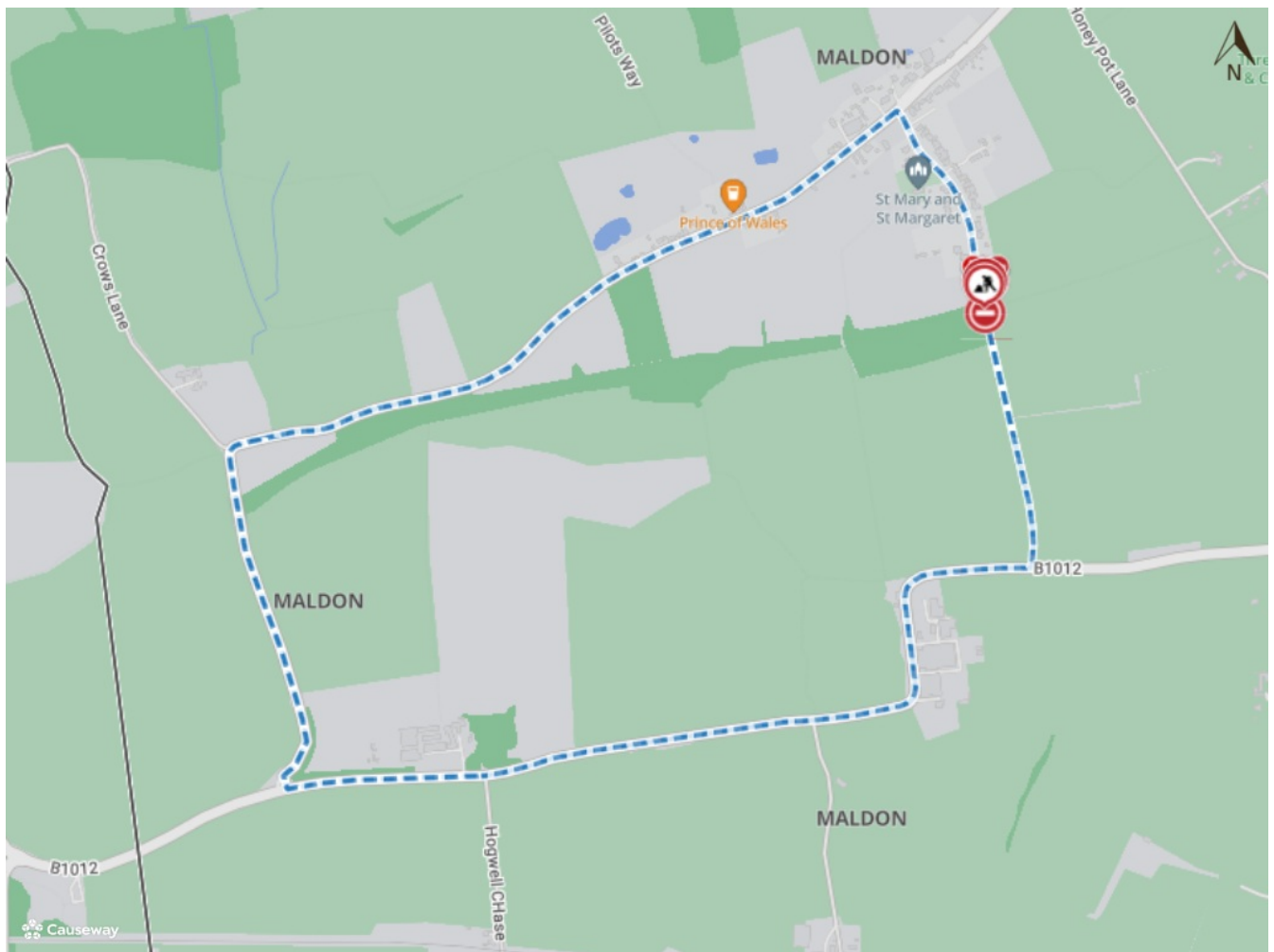
Access for emergency services and pedestrians is being maintained at all times.
