## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2025**

**UK Power Networks works.** 

To allow underground cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Poplar Road, Wittersham.

A closure is planned from 14th April 2025, with estimated completion by 16th April 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50008020066-03 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <a href="One-Network">One-Network</a>

Poplar Road will be closed between Swan Cottages and Forge Meads, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while underground cabling works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2082 Poplar Road, Stocks Road, A268 Rye Road, Wittersham Road, Iden Road, Main Street, Grove Lane, Flackley Ash, Barnets Hill, Two Hovens, Peasmarsh Road, Whitebread Lane, Stoddards Lane, A28 Station Road, Hastings Road, High Street, Tenterden Road, Rolvenden Hill, Rolvenden Road, B2082 Smallhythe Road and Peening Quarter Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
