THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2025

UK Power Networks works.

To allow tree cutting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Swain Road, Tenterden.

A closure is planned from 18th February 2025, for up to one day, between the hours of 09:00 and 17:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50097229627-02 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Swain Road will be closed from outside Oak Tree Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while tree cutting works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Swain Road, Swan Road, B2067 Woodchurch Road, B2080 Beacon Oak Road, Ashford Road and Swain Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
