(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2025

UK Power Networks works.

To allow excavation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2080 Appledore Road, Tenterden.

A closure is planned from 20th February 2025, with estimated completion by 21st February 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50006143177-03 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

B2080 Appledore Road will be closed in the vicinity of Goddens, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while excavation works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2080 Appledore Road, B2067 Golden Square, Oaks Road, A28 High Street, B2082 Smallhythe Road, Peening Quarter Road, Poplar Road, Stocks Road, Rye Road, B2080 Wittersham Road, B2082 Iden Road, Main Street, Iden Road, A268 Rye Road, Rye Hill, Fishmarket Road, A259 New Road, Brookland Bypass, B2080 Rhee Wall, Station Road, The Street, Tenterden Road, Reading Street and Appledore Road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
