(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2025

Southern Water works.

To allow manhole frame and cover replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A28 Ashford Road, High Halden.

A closure is planned from 22:00 hours on 4th February 2025, with estimated completion by 06:30 hours on 5th February 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ003SWAT13352834-11 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A28 Ashford Road will be closed opposite the junction with Halden Close, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while manhole frame and cover replacement works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A28 Ashford Road, B2080 Beacon Oak Road, B2067 Beacon Oak Road, Woodchurch Road, Brook Street, Front Road, Bethersden Road, Plurenden Road, Woodchurch Road, Church Hill and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
