THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2025

Kent County Council works.

To allow highway improvement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A229 Highgate Hill, Hawkhurst.

Restrictions are planned from 7th May 2025, with estimated completion by 28th June 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27836890476-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A229 Highgate Hill will be closed from the junction of A268 Rye Road to the junction of Mercers, between the hours of 07:00 and 19:00 on Monday to Friday, 08:00 and 17:00 on Saturdays and 09:00 and 17:00 on Sundays only. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

A no parking restriction will be in place on A229 Highgate Hill. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce to allow highway improvement works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A229 Highgate Hill, A229 Moor Hill, A229 The Moor, A229 Horns Hill, A229 Horns Road, A229 Horns Hill, A229 Merriments Lane, A21 London Road, A268 Hawkhurst Road, A268 High Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
