THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2025

South East Water works.

To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2080 Tenterden Road, Appledore.

A closure is planned from 15th December 2025, with estimated completion by 17th December 2025, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB009-B1256-02 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

B2080 Tenterden Road will be closed in the vicinity of Coxland Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new connection works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2080 Tenterden Road, Reading Street, Appledore Road, B2067 Woodchurch Road, Brook Street, Kenardington Road, Warehorne Road, D1305 11 Acre Wood Lane Junction With B2067 To D1291 Junction With D1305 11 Acre Wood Lane, Ashford Road, Ashford Road Junction With Bypass Link Road To Hamstreet, A2070 From J A2070/B2080 Roundabout To J A2042, Hamstreet Bypass, A2070 From Ashford Road To District Boundary, A2070 Rhee Wall To Ashford Road, A259 J A2070/B2080 Roundabout, Rhee Wall Roundabout, B2080 Rhee Wall, Brenzett Corner Roundabout, Rhee Wall Road, Station Road, The Street and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
