THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2026

SOUTH EAST WATER LIMITED works.

To allow new connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Chennell Park Road, Tenterden.

A closure is planned from 12th May 2026, with estimated completion by 14th May 2026, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB009-B1521-01 - SOUTH EAST WATER LIMITED). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Chennell Park Road will be closed in the vicinity of Potts Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new connection works are undertaken by SOUTH EAST WATER LIMITED.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Chennell Park Road, Grange Road, A28 Ashford Road, Silver Hill, Beacon Oak Road, East Cross, High Street, West Cross, Rolvenden Road, Cranbrook Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
