Openreach works.

To allow pole and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Gribble Bridge Lane, Biddenden.

A closure is planned from 27th August 2026 with estimated completion by 28th August 2026, between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WH1VJ22D-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Gribble Bridge Lane will be closed approximately 70m east of Gribble Bridge Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole and cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Gribble Bridge Lane, Benenden Road, Tenterden Road, Biddenden Road, Bugglesden Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
