TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF THE HIGHWAY BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES

LOCATION: Henley-on-Thames, Reading Road (A4155)

REASON: Facilitate the resurfacing of the carriageway and subsequent reinstatement of all lines and road markings

DURATION: Starting on 15 September 2025
The anticipated end date is 20 September 2025 date include
(each night from 20:00hrs to 06:00hrs)
(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)

ACCESS: Limited access will be maintained for local buses, emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Traffic wishing to use the A4155 Reading Road to access Henley will be diverted back south along the A4155 through Shiplake to Reading, to turn northwest along the A4074 to Wallingford, to turn southeast along the A4130 passing through Nettlebed and returning to Henley, and vice versa.

The diversion route has been approved by Reading Borough Council as it also utilises part of the neighboring authority network.
