**Temporary Closure of Slait Hill To Haygrove Lane**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, propose to make an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;  
**Slait Hill To Haygrove Lane** - from 370 metres east of the junction with Slait Hill, eastwards for a total distance of **90 metres**

This Order will enable **Milestone Infrastructure to carry out earthworks.**

The Order becomes effective on 21 July 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **25th July 2022** and last until **12th August 2022** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **19 days**.
