Temporary Closure of Glanville Road

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;
Glanville Road - from 57 metres north-east of the junction with Guildhall Lane, north-eastwards for a total distance of **52 metres**

This Order will enable **Bristol Water to carry out new connection works.**

The Order becomes effective on 03 March 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **8th March 2022** and last until **11th March 2022** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **4 days**.

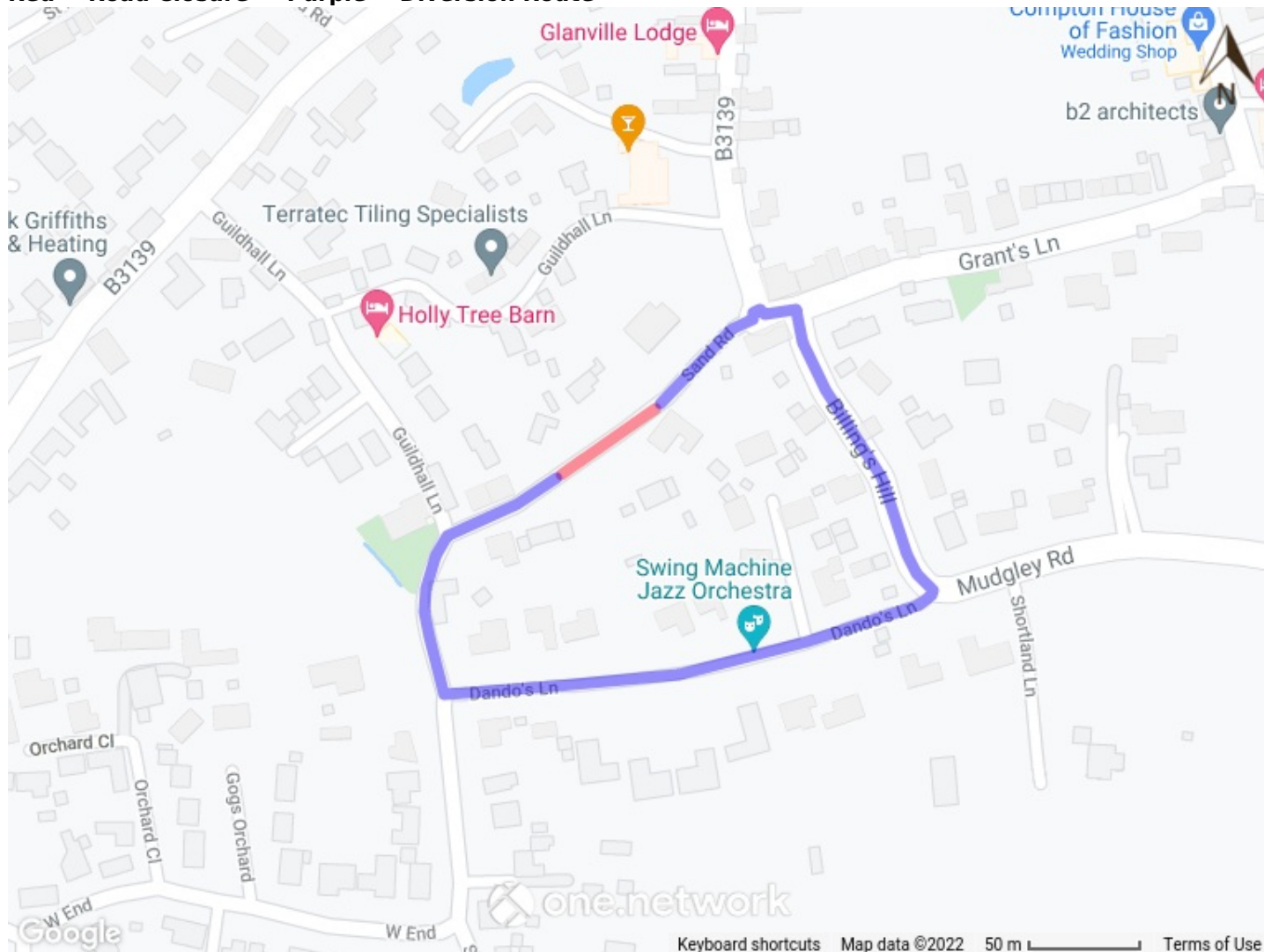
