Temporary Closure of Silver Street and Lincolm Hill

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Silver Street - from the junction with Great Lane, north westwards for a distance of 700 metres and

Lincolm Hill - from the junction with Marsh Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 330 metres.

A total distance of 1030 metres.

This Order will enable Western Power Distribution to carry out the removal of rotten ash trees around power lines.

The Order becomes effective on 17th March 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **21st March 2022** and last until **25th March 2022** between the hours of **09:30** - **15:30** for a total of **5 days**.


