Temporary Closure of Lascot Hill

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Lascot Hill - from the junction with Lane between Middle Stoughton & Stoughton Cross, south eastwards for a distance of 101 metres.

This Order will enable **Bristol Water to carry out works to replace a stop tap.**

The Order becomes effective on 31st March 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **6th April 2022** and last until **8th April 2022** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **3 days**.

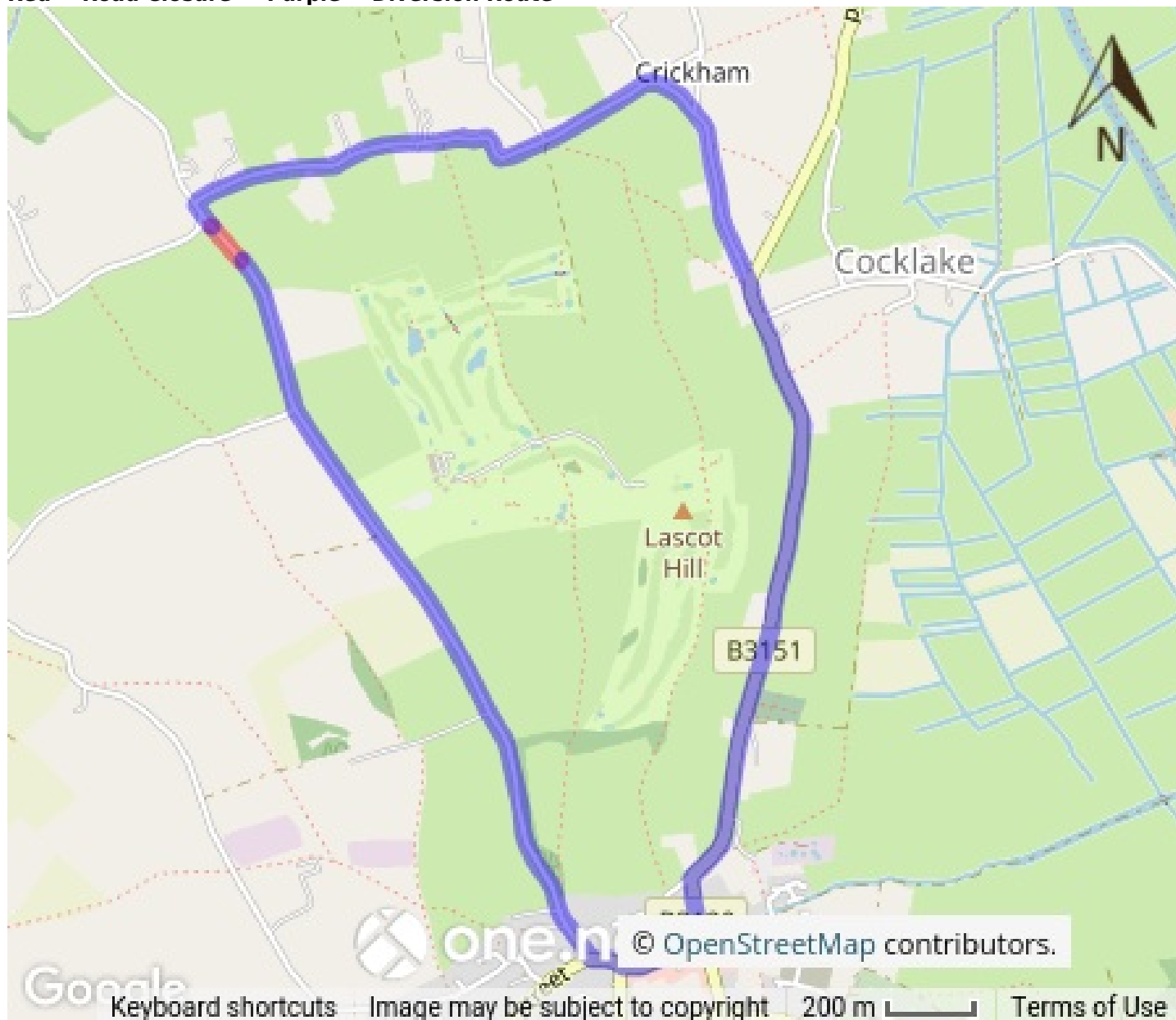
