Temporary Closure of Knowle Lane

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Knowle Lane - from the junction with Hornsbury Hill, north eastwards for a distance of 1360 metres.

This Order will enable **BT Openreach to carry out overhead fibre cabling and tree cutting works.**

The Order becomes effective on 28th April 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **4th May 2022** and last until **6th May 2022** between the hours of **09:30 - 15:30** for a total of **3 days**.
