Temporary Closure of Pinkham Hill

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;
Pinkham Hill - from the junction with Knowle Church Road, north eastwards for a total distance of **103 metres**

This Order will enable **Wessex Water to carry out new connection works.**

The Order becomes effective on 10 March 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **14th March 2022** and last until **16th March 2022** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **3 days**.
