## **Temporary Closure of Woolavington Road**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along; **Woolavington Road -** from the junction with East Approach Road, eastwards for a total distance of **107 metres** 

This Order will enable Wessex Water to carry out PRV service works.

The Order becomes effective on 10th May 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **16th May 2022** and last until **18th May 2022** between the hours of **00:00** - **23:59** for a total of **3 days**.


