Temporary Closure of Woolavington Road and Higher Road

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;
Woolavington Road - from the junction with Lower Road, westwards for 442 metres and
Higher Road - from the junction with Lower Road. eastwards for 130 metres.
A total distance of **572 metres**

This Order will enable **BT Openreach to carry out cabling and jointing works.**

The Order becomes effective on 31st May 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **11th June 2022** and last until **12th June 2022** between the hours of **09:30 - 15:30** for a total of **2 days**.

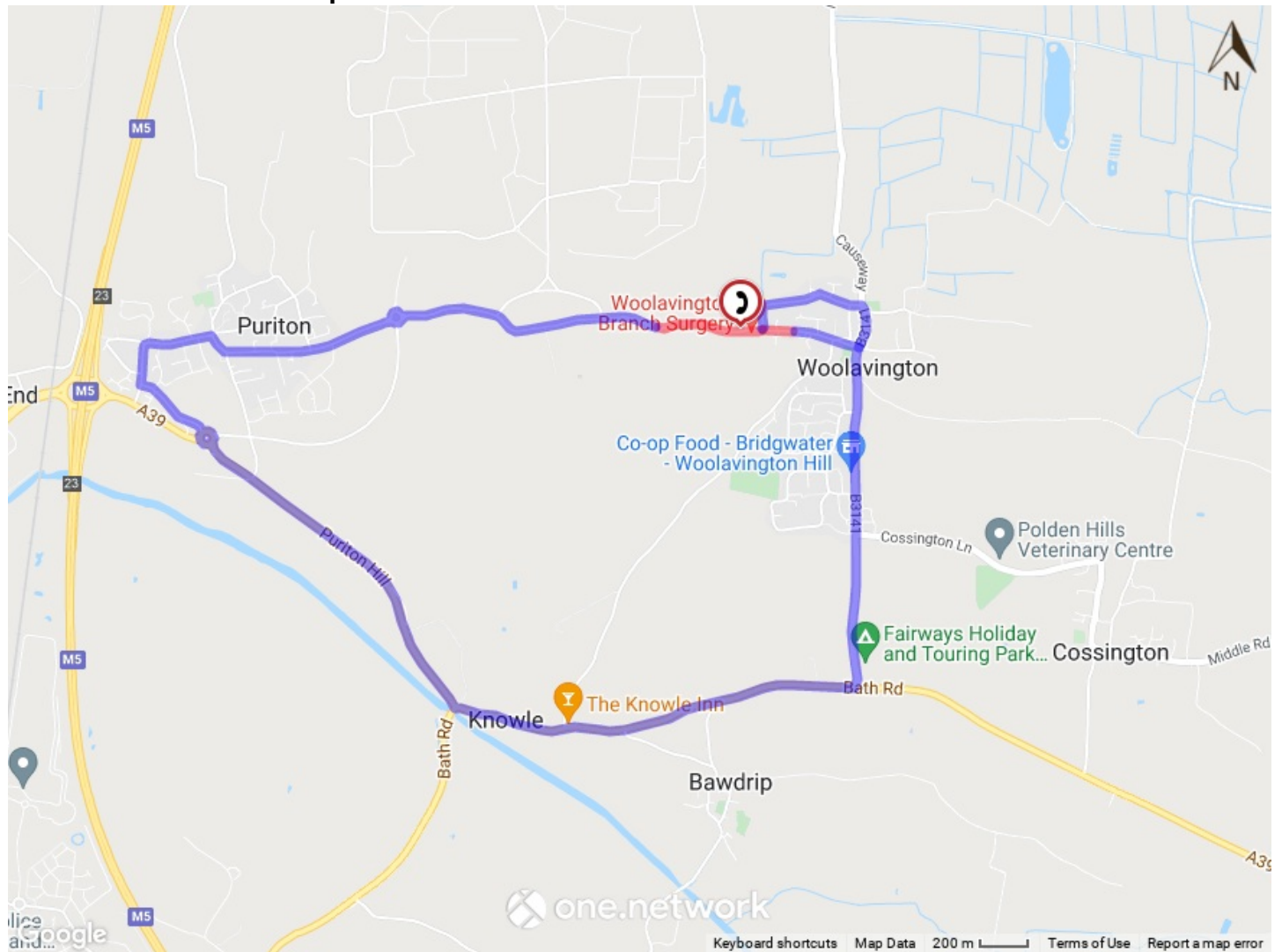
