Temporary Closure of Three Corner Mead and F1152/150 Footway between Preston Road & Stourton Way

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting pedestrian traffic for the footpath and traffic for the road closure from proceeding along;

Three Corner Mead - for its entire length

F1152/150 Footway between Preston Road & Stourton Way - from Three Corner Mead, northwards for a distance of 31 metres

for a total distance of 70 metres

This Order will enable Jurassic Fibre to carry out core drilling and overlay works.

The Order becomes effective on 11th August 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. (six months for the footpath) The works are expected to commence on **15th August 2022** and last until **17th August 2022** between the hours of **08:00** - **17:00** for a total of **3 days**.


