Temporary Closure of High Street

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

High Street - from the junction with Underway, south eastwards for a total distance of **30 metres**.

This Order will enable **Wessex Water to carry out sewer repair works**.

The Order becomes effective on 25th August 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **30th August 2022** and last until **1st September 2022** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **3 days**.

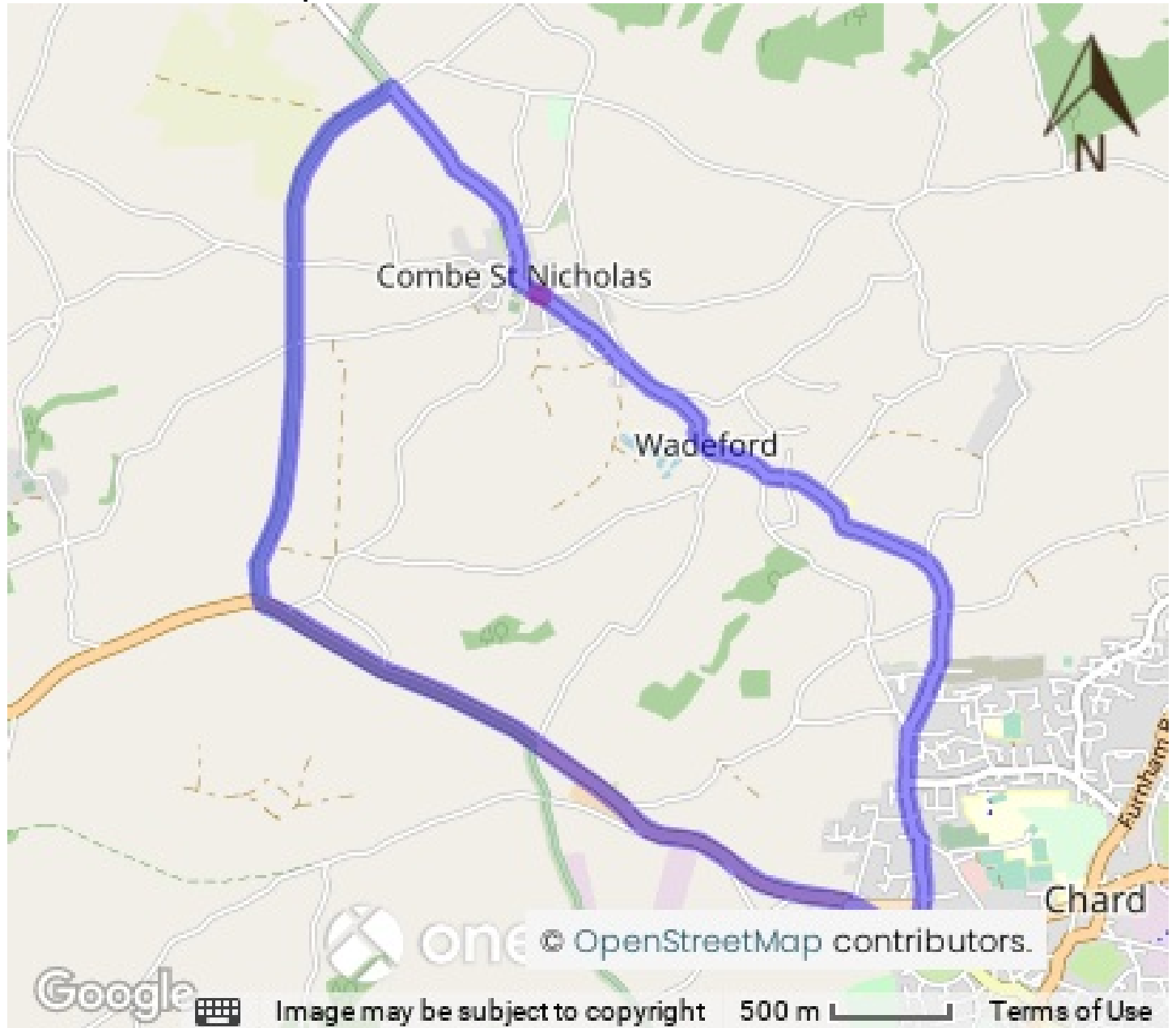
