Temporary Closure of Cossington Lane

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;
Cossington Lane - from 30metres east of the junction with Southfield Close, eastwards for a total distance of **442 metres**

This Order will enable **Wessex Water to carry out new connection works.**

The Order becomes effective on 16th August 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **22nd August 2022** and last until **23rd September 2022** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **33 days**.

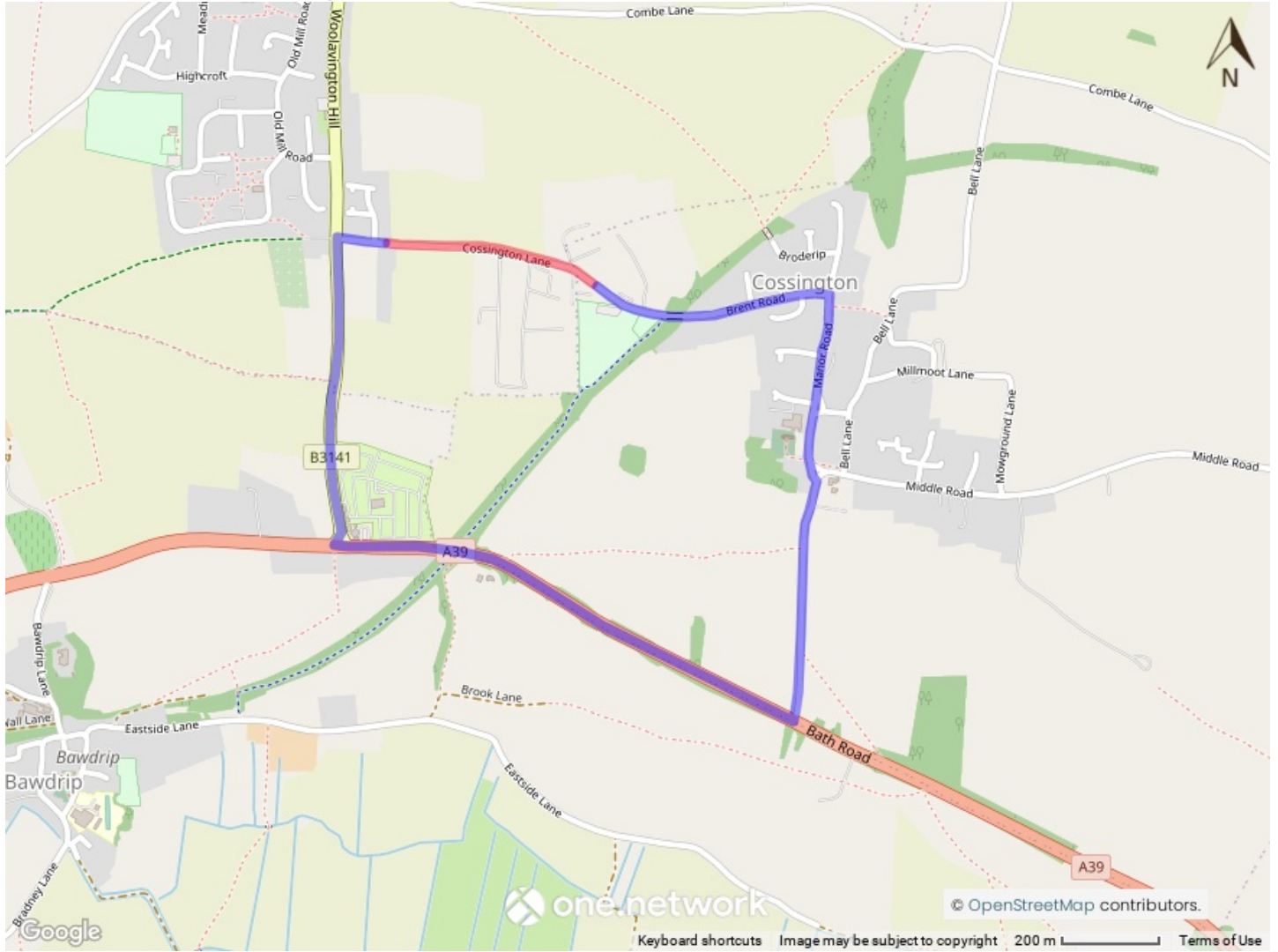
