Temporary Closure of School Lane

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;
School Lane - from the junction with New Road, southwards for a total distance of **50 metres**.

This Order will enable **Wessex Water to carry out utility repair and maintenance works**.

The Order becomes effective on 17th November 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **23rd November 2022** and last until **24th November 2022** between the hours of **07:00 - 15:30** for a total of **2 days**.
