Temporary Closure of Wares Lane, Wembdon Rise (B3339) and Cycle Lane

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Wares Lane - from the junction with Wembdon Rise (B3339, eastwards for 20 metres; **Wembdon Rise (B3339) -** from the junction with Inwood Road, southwards to the junction with Homberg Way (A39) a distance of 310 metres and

Cycle Lane - from the junction with Homberg Way (A39) and Wembdon Rise (B3339) for a distance of 10 metres.

A total distance of 340 metres.

This Order will enable Jurassic Fibre to carry out works in Wares Lane to clear 2 x blockages. Wembdon Rise and Cycle Lane to provide overlay works.

The Order becomes effective on 3rd January 2023 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The phased works are expected to commence on **9th January 2023** and last until **11th January 2023** between the hours of **00:00** - **23:59** for a total of **3 days**.
