Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along; **Kingstone Main -** from the junction with Kingston Hill, eastwards to the junction with Longforward Lane. A distance of **580 metres.**

Boyton Hill - from the junction with Castles Hill, south-eastwards to the junction with Kingston Road. A distance of **1050 metres.** And

Kingson Road - from the junction with Boyton Lane, eastwards to the junction with Dozens Lane. A distance of **345 metres.**

A total distance of 1955 metres

This Order will enable Openreach to carry out cabling works.

The Order becomes effective on 23rd March 2023 and will remain in force for eighteen months. These phased works are expected to commence on **27th March 2023** and last until **11th April 2023** between the hours of **09:30** - **15:30** for a total of **16 days**.
