**Temporary Closure of Court Barton and Wharf Lane Footpath**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Court Barton** - from the junction with Silver Street, northwards for a distance of **60 metres** and **Wharf Lane Footpath** - from the junction with Silver Street, southwards for a distance of **70 metres**.

A total Distance of **130 metres**.

This Order will enable **National Grid to carry out supply alteration work**.

The Order becomes effective on 13th July 2023 and will remain in force for eighteen months for Court Barton and six months for Wharf Lane Footpath. These phased works are expected to commence on **17th July 2023** and last until **12th September 2023** between the hours of **08:00 - 16:00** for a total of **58 days**.
