Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Somerton Road, Bartletts Elm Roundabout - from the junction with Newtown, north-eastwards for a distance of **624 metres**; And

Newtown - from the junction with Somerton Road, northwards for a distance of **15 metres**. A total distance of **639 metres**.

This Order will enable Milestone Infrastructure to carry out resurfacing work.

The Order becomes effective on 27th July 2023 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **1st August 2023** and last until **11th August 2023** between the hours of **18:30** - **23:30** for a total of **11 days**.
