Temporary Closure of St John Street

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

St John Street - from the junction with Westonzoyland Road, westwards for a total distance of **279 metres**.

This Order will enable **Milestone Infrastructure to carry out structural maintenance in the footway**.

The Order becomes effective on 18th July 2023 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **24th July 2023** and last until **28th July 2023** between the hours of **08:00 -17:00** for a total of **5 days**.
