Temporary Closure of Bineham Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Bineham Road - from the junction with Bineham Lane to the junction with Stone Mead Lane. A total distance of **988 metres**.

This Order will enable **Openreach to excavate and lay duct**.

The Order becomes effective on 24th August 2023 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **29th August 2023** and last until **4th September 2023** between the hours of **08:00 - 18:00** for a total of **7 days**.
