Temporary Closure of Jarmany Hill

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Jarmany Hill - from 500 metres south-east of the junction with Banbury Lane, south-eastwards for a total distance of **68 metres.**

This Order will enable Wessex Water to install a water main to a new development.

The Order becomes effective on 23rd November 2023 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **27th November 2023** and last until **8th December 2023** between the hours of **00:00** - **23:59** for a total of **12 days**.
