**Temporary Closure of Jarmany Hill**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Jarmany Hill** - from 500 metres south-east of the junction with Banbury Lane, south-eastwards for a total distance of **68 metres**.

This Order will enable **Wessex Water to install a water main to a new development**.

The Order becomes effective on 23rd November 2023 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **27th November 2023** and last until **8th December 2023** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **12 days**.
