Charlynch Road - from 112 metres south-west of the junction with Charlynch Hill, southwestwards for a total distance of **486 metres.**

This Order will enable Utility Services Ltd to replace a pole on behalf of Openreach.

The Order becomes effective on 23rd January 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **2nd February 2024** and last until **2nd February 2024** between the hours of **08:00** - **16:00** for a total of **8 hours**.
