Bullhorn Drove - from the junction with Westonzoyland Road to the junction with Lakewall, as and when signed on site;

Andersea Road - from the junction with Bullhorn Drove for it's entirety.

Lakewall - from 483 metres south-west of the junction with School Road, south-westwards for a distance of 1554 metres, as and when signed on site and

Hoopers Lane - from the junction with River Road to the junction with Lakewall.

A total distance of 6291 metres.

This Order will enable Splicetek Communications Ltd to carry out phased works to install new cables on behalf of Airband Community Internet Ltd.

The Order becomes effective on 23rd January 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **29th January 2024** and last until **9th February 2024** between the hours of **08:00** - **16:30** for a total of **12 days**.
