

**Somerset Council**

**Temporary Closure of Ham Hill**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Ham Hill** - from from 140 metres south of the junction with Princes Close, south-eastwards for a total distance of **134 metres**.

This Order will enable **Wales and West Utilities to provide a new gas connection**.

The Order becomes effective on 08th February 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **12th February 2024** and last until **16th February 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **5 days**.
