Temporary Closure of Andersea Road and Bullhorn Drove

Andersea Road - from the junction with Bullhorn Drove, for its entirety and **Bullhorn Drove** - from the junction with Westonzoyland Road to the junction with Andersea Road. A total distance of **2502 metres.**

This Order will enable Barr Engineering Services to install twelve poles on behalf of Airband.

The Order becomes effective on 06th February 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **12th February 2024** and last until **14th February 2024** between the hours of **08:00** - **18:00** for a total of **3 days**.
