Temporary Closure of Portway Hill To Waddon Farm, Taddywood Lane and Portway Hill

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Portway Hill To Waddon Farm - from the junction with Taddywood Lane, north-eastwards incorporating **Portway Hill** for a total distance of **517 metres** and

Taddywood Lane - from the junction with Portway Hill to Waddon Farm, southwards for a distance of **280 metres**.

A total distance of **797 metres**.

This Order will enable **Wessex Internet to install fibre cables**.

The Order becomes effective on 29th February 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **4th March 2024** and last until **8th March 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **5 days**.
