**Temporary Closure of Penzoy Avenue, Loxleigh Avenue and Loxleigh Gardens**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Penzoy Avenue** - from the junction with Westonzoyland Road to the junction with Loxleigh Avenue;  
Loxleigh Avenue - from the junction with Loxleigh Gardens, north-westwards for a distance of **38 metres** and  
Loxleigh Gardens - from the junction with Penzoy Avenue, southwards for a distance of **14 metres**.  
A total distance of **179 metres**.

This Order will enable **Future Networks Inc. Ltd to install cables and fibreoptics on behalf of Jurassic Fibre**.

The Order becomes effective on 27th February 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **4th March 2024** and last until **27th March 2024** between the hours of **08:00 - 17:00** for a total of **24 days**.
