Temporary Closure of Acre Lane and New Street

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Acre Lane, - from the junction with Huish Road to Acre Lane to the junction with New Hill; and **New Street** - from the junction with New Hill, westwards for a distance of 109 metres. A total distance of **443 metres.**

This Order will enable Wessex Internet to install fibre cables.

The Order becomes effective on 25th April 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **29th April 2024** and last until **3rd May 2024** between the hours of **00:00** - **23:59** for a total of **5 days**.
