

**Somerset Council**

**Temporary Closure of Acre Lane and New Street**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Acre Lane**, - from the junction with Huish Road to Acre Lane to the junction with New Hill; and  
**New Street** - from the junction with New Hill, westwards for a distance of 109 metres.  
A total distance of **443 metres**.

This Order will enable **Wessex Internet to install fibre cables**.

The Order becomes effective on 25th April 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **29th April 2024** and last until **3rd May 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **5 days**.
