

**Somerset Council**

**Temporary Closure of Ham Lane**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Ham Lane** - from the junction with Hurst Drove to the junction with Castlebrook . A total distance of **917 metres**.

This Order will enable **Wessex Water to carry out phased sewer improvement works (as and when signed on site)**.

The Order becomes effective on 30th May 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. These phased works are expected to commence on **3rd June 2024** and last until **21st June 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **19 days**.
