Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Ham Lane - from the junction with Hurst Drove to the junction with Castlebrook . A total distance of **917 metres.**

This Order will enable Wessex Water to carry out phased sewer improvement works (as and when signed on site).

The Order becomes effective on 30th May 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. These phased works are expected to commence on **3rd June 2024** and last until **21st June 2024** between the hours of **00:00** - **23:59** for a total of **19 days**.
